You are invited to join the Wisconsin Dance Council (WDC) on Saturday, August 18, 2018, at the Jane Bergstrom Fine Arts Center, Neenah WI, for our **Conference and Award Ceremony**.

This one day gathering will have nationally known presenters for both students and teachers. Students will have the opportunity to study Hip Hop with **Cedric Gardner** and Bollywood with **Cyenthia Vijayakumar**, and at the same time receive individual written feedback from professionals in the dance field. Dance educators will also have the opportunity to participate in professional development with a nationally known guest—**Rhee Gold!** There will also be a session where educators/teachers can learn about different collegiate dance programs in Wisconsin. This will be the time to ask questions about preparing your students the audition process and parents can sit in on the session with the collegiate program representatives.

This year Master Classes will be divided into two groups; Juniors (Grades 6-8) and Seniors (Grades 9-12). College students can participate in the Master Classes or attend the Professional Development. All students who participates in the Master Classes will receive feedback on their dancing given by professionals highly recognized in the field. Also, everyone who participates in the Master Classes will participate in the performance later in the afternoon.

The afternoon performance will celebrate our honorees that are being recognized for their outstanding contributions to dance in Wisconsin. Our honorees are Mary Katic (Career Recognition), Dani Kuepper (Choreography/Performance), Marlene Skog (Distinction), Marlene Turbin Weldon (Career Recognition), and Roger White (Lifetime Achievement). The performance will also honor Inductees of the National Honor Society for the Dance Arts. There will be a reception following the Award Ceremony.

There will also be vendor and service providers on site to visit with. You can order lunch or bring your own. **Please be aware the early registration deadline for the conference, ordering t-shirts, and lunches is July 15, 2018.** If you are unable to attend the event, you can still order a t-shirt on the registration form and we will mail it to you!

Master Class Dance Artist Biographies

Cyenthia Vijayakumar is a trained Kathak (Indian classical dance) and Bollywood dancer who has been performing and teaching the art form. She has performed all over India and America in many platforms. Mrs. Vijayakumar has also conducted Bollywood and and choreographed many dance routines for various events. You may have seen Cyenthia perform at Danceworks DanceLAB: Get It Out There this January!

Cedric Gardner, a top 14 finalist on the third season of the American dance contest series, "So You Think You Can Dance", began dancing with his mother at the age of seven years old. He studied for two years at the Peck School of the Arts at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and practiced at the "Millennium Dance Company" and the "Edge Performing Arts Center" in Los Angeles. At the age of eighteen Cedric, created "Fuel", a Milwaukee based Hip Hop dance company, where he choreographed full length shows. During this time, he also performed with Neil Young's "Greendale", and under his artistic direction performed on opening for entertainers such as; Little Bow Wow, India Arie, and Fantasia Burino.

While on the "So You Think You Can Dance" show, Cedric was given a full scholarship to the "Debbie Allen Dance Academy", which he accepted. Opportunities have continued for Cedric after appearing on "So You Think You Can Dance".

Professional Development – Marketing with Rhee Gold

Rhee Gold is a dance field pioneer who has single-handedly led a movement that continues to change and improve the face of dance education. Teachers from all over the world flock to his retreats, seminars, keynote speeches, and conferences to gain fresh perspectives and learn positive solutions that inspire new levels of empowerment, self-confidence and personal accomplishment. Rhee was a competitive dancer where he gained the title of Mr. Dance of America. As a teacher Rhee's students are performing professionally, while others are teachers and school owners.

In 2012 he opened the doors to the DanceLife Retreat Center, where hundreds of dance teachers and school owners attend business seminars, curriculum workshops and motivational weekends. His DanceLife Teacher Conference is one of the largest gatherings of dance educators in the world. As the owner and publisher of Dance Studio Life (DSL) magazine, he is the leader of the largest publication for dance education in the United States. Rhee also owns the DanceTeacherStore.com. His latest endeavor,



The International Dance Entrepreneurs Association (IDEA) is a first of its kind association for dance school owners

He was the President of Dance Masters of New England, Dance Masters of America and the Founding Co-Chair of UNITY. He is the author of The Complete Guide to Teaching Dance: An Insider's Secrets to Personal Reward and Financial Success, now in its second printing, In 2014 Rhee received the Lifetime Achievement Award from the Industry Dance Awards and he received the same award from Dance Educators of America in 2015 and Dance Masters of New England in 2016.

Next Stop: College: Have a chance to chat with some of the best collegiate dance programs in the state. Learn about audition processes, program descriptions and how to better prepare your dancers for the next stage of their education. Parents are also welcome to listen in on this beneficial panel presentation. Representatives in attendance (at the time of printing) are from University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, and Carthage College.
